WBC: I enclose check or money order made payable to BPA to register for WBC 2006. Payment is based on date of arrival. Badges picked up before time are subject to a \$10 surcharge per day. Payment accompanying registration must be received no later than July 22nd, 2006. Thereafter, higher at-the-door fees apply. NOTE: Associate and BPA Membership discounts are available only to pre-registrants; they are NOT applicable at the door. There will be a \$2 badge holder replacement fee for those who do not bring their WBC badge holder from prior years.

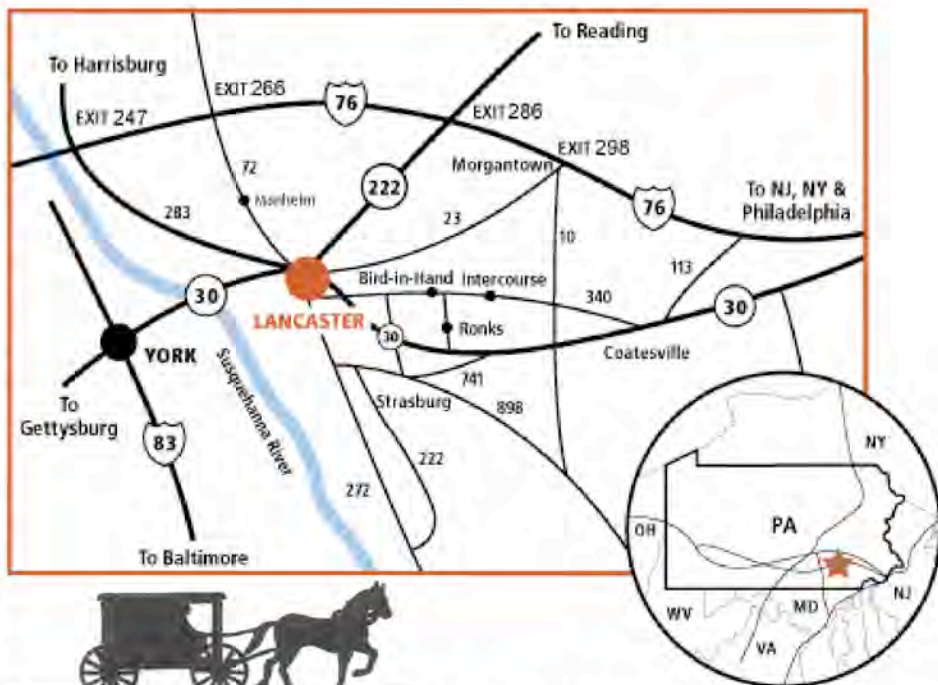

WBC BOARDGAMES AUCTION: On Tuesday, from 10 AM to 4 PM, WBC will hold a Game Auction for the sale of boardgames, non-collectible card games, and accessories pertaining to same. Registration for the auction will be held between 8 & 10 PM, Monday, and 8 AM till noon on Tuesday, August 1st. However, pre-registration of items for sale is recommended due to the limit of items to be accepted. Full details pertaining to the auction are available on pages 87-88 of your program and on <http://www.boardgamers.org/wbc/auction.htm> which will be updated weekly with a list of pre-registered items for sale. Plan to come early this year to enjoy the auction, content in the knowledge that you won't be missing any other events, while you look for that long out of print classic that has been eluding you all these years.

ADMISSION: BPA membership (inherent in price of admission) is required unless using a one-day guest pass. Spectators are admitted free to patronize vendors, but Open Gaming and all events are limited to BPA members or guests with a valid WBC badge. Children 12 and under accompanied by a member may participate in free "Juniors-only" tournaments or pay the prevailing fee to participate in any event. There are no event fees other than those required for Pre-cons. Flea markets, product displays and the selling or promotion of any item on the premises is prohibited to all except authorized vendors.

EVENTS: There is no pre-registration for events. You may participate in as many events as you like, but only one at a time. To guarantee inclusion, bring the game (to ensure sufficient copies) and be on time. Wear your badge at all times. To confirm your registration status for WBC and/or the Pre-Cons, or to seek carpool, roommates, Open Gaming matches or teammates check <http://www.boardgamers.org/wbc/prereg.htm>. PRIZES: Tournament prizes consist of BPA plaques. Century event prizes include a Century shirt and two to six such plaques based on a formula derived from 2005 player hours in each event. Trial and Junior events receive only one such plaque. The prizes of some events are supplemented by merchandise credits from the publisher or items donated by the GM. See each event's detailed web preview for prize details.



CLASS: All WBC events are color coded in a traffic light analogy throughout our website, program, and event kiosk presentations for required experience levels. **A (Red):** Advanced players only. Rules are not explained. **B (Yellow):** Beginners welcome. Rules are taught only at the scheduled teaching demonstration in Paradise Terrace - the GM does not teach during the event. **C (Green):** Coached. Beginners will be taught during play of the event.

JUNIOR EVENTS: There are 24 tournaments free for children 12 and under able to read and accompanied by an adult member. See <http://www.boardgamers.org/yearbkex/jnrpge.htm>.

HOTEL: The WBC Room rate is \$89 per day for one-to-four guests per room. Applicable state taxes bring that total to \$98.79. A check or money order covering the first night's stay, or submission of the entire number of your major credit card including expiration date and signature is required to make a reservation. No reservation will be accepted unless secured in this manner. Reservations cancelled within 30 days of the reserved arrival date will be assessed a one night's room and tax penalty to their credit card or forfeit their first night room deposit. Specify any other guests with whom you will share the room at the time of your reservation.

At this time, Lancaster Host is sold out for most of WBC week. Fortunately, there are many hotels within easy walking distance. However, cancellations do occur and the Host is acting as our Housing Agent for overflow reservations. Therefore, you should continue to call the Host to book your stay and they will make your reservation in the nearest comparable hotel where we have established a roomblock with matching discounted rates. Not only will this get you the best deal in the most convenient lodging, but it will also credit the BPA with your stay and thereby reduce your future WBC costs as well.
